Beginner's Beekeeping Course:

Join the Association beginner's beekeeping course starting in March 2025 to be ready in the spring for the start of the season.

The beginner's beekeeping course aims to provide prospective beekeepers with:

- An understanding of the ecological and economic importance of the honeybee;
- The basic theoretical knowledge required for the meaningful examination and successful management of a colony of honeybees;
- The basic understanding of UK regulations regarding selling honeybee produce;
- The practical skills necessary to handle bees with confidence.

This is an informal, non-examination course where no previous knowledge or experience is required. The course consists of four 4-hour sessions on 2nd, 16th, 23rd & 30th March 2024, followed by two practical skills sessions in April along with monthly apiary meetings to gain hands-on experience handling bees. Theory, and practical training over 12months for just £110.

The beekeeping course taught by the Association is aimed at new and hobbyist beekeepers. If you are new to beekeeping, this is an ideal opportunity to learn more about beekeeping from local beekeepers with almost 100 years combined beekeeping experience.
